The Town Council of the Town of Cedar Bluff, County of Cherokee, State of Alabama, met in Special Called Session in the Council Room at Town Hall, 3420 Martha Vera Lane, Cedar Bluff, Alabama on Monday, September 26, 2016 at 3:30 p.m. pursuant to notice duly posted as prescribed by law. The invocation was given by Councilmember Leatha Harp.  
Mayor Crane led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**1. Approval of Authorized Hours for Alcohol Sales on Sunday**

Mayor Crane stated that there had been a mix up on the hours for Sunday alcohol sales. She told the council that the hours in the current alcohol ordinance were from 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday and 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on Saturday. She said the town's attorney had advised to have some set hours on Sunday and Monday. Mayor Crane suggested making the hours the same for every day of the week. Councilmember Donald Sanders made the motion to amend the hours of prohibited sales to 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. for Sunday through Saturday for on premise consumption and no prohibited hours for off premises retailers and Councilmember Norman Burton seconded the motion.

Next Mayor Crane announced the town's ditching project would soon begin and she asked each councilmember to turn in a list of ditches that need to be worked on in their district.

Councilmember Leatha Harp expressed concerns for ponies that are brought in this time each year and put on a small lot in the town for several weeks. She also asked about a resident that has built a building and opened a yard sale daily for the past several weeks. Her concern was if they have a business license. Discussion was made concerning the town's peddlers license and the need to see what should be done concerning yard sales in the town. It was decided to look into it for the next workshop meeting.
