BE IT RESOLVED that Tammy Crane, the Mayor of the Town, be and she is hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of the Town to execute a Lease Agreement with Alabama Power Company, to construct and operate a park located on the property identified as a portion of that certain property identified on the Cherokee County Tax Assessor' Map as Parcel ID Number 13-10-09-29-3-000-006.001; located in the NW1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 29 and in the NE ¹/₄ of the SE1/4 of Section 30, all in Township 9 South, Range 10 East of the Huntsville Meridian; and recorded in Map Book A49, page 7, in the Probate Office of Cherokee County, Alabama.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Mayor is further authorized to execute said act on such terms and conditions, considerations and stipulations as the said Mayor shall deem necessary and proper, and to sign and deliver such other acts, instruments and documents which may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
