Rebuild Alabama Act

**WHEREAS**, the 2019 Alabama Legislature has passed an HB2 to levy additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel, and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedar Bluff is to receive a portion of said tax and


**WHEREAS**, the town of Cedar Bluff pledges to keep this money in a separate fund and expend only for maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and as mandated by the law passed, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Cedar Bluff is to adopt an annual transportation plan no later than August 31 for the next fiscal year based on an estimate of revenues

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the town of Cedar Bluff intends to spend the expected funds of \$15,778 for maintenance, roadway improvements, resurfacing and construction of roads within our existing street/road network during said fiscal year from the Cedar Bluff Street Evaluation Summary performed by Ladd Environmental in 2015.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, the Town of Cedar Bluff has caused this fiscal year 2020 Town of Cedar Bluff Transportation plan to be executed in its name and on its behalf by its Mayor and Clerk on this 19<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2019, which was passed at a Special Meeting of the Town of Cedar Bluff Town Council.
